1. Download and complete the [YEP Team Name List](#) found under section “Required Documents for Application”
2. Email completed YEP Team Name List (orange cells only) to the respective emails found in the schedule below with the following email subject title: **LRDB Registration: <Session Code> at least 3 days before the session**. Late or incomplete submissions will be rejected.
3. You should receive an acknowledgement email if registration is successful.
4. Registration is on a **first-come-first-served** basis hence teams are encouraged to sign up early to avoid disappointment.

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FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS (FAQ)

1. Our Little Red Dot and Beyond? What it is?

- “Our Little Red Dot and Beyond” (LRDB) is a **training** for participants of the Youth Expedition Project (YEP) **to allow participants to understand additional perspectives and the significance of their roles**. The 3-hour programme will cover the following topics: (1) The Little Red Dot and the Singaporean Identity, (2) Our Neighbours and Friends: ASEAN and Beyond, and (3) Youths and Volunteerism.

2. Who should attend?

- This training is only open to YEP participants.

3. When should I attend this training?

- YEP teams should register for this training after the team is formed.
- This training is to be attended **before** embarking on your YEP Overseas Project.

4. Is this training compulsory?

- **Yes, this training is compulsory** so that all YEP participants gain additional perspectives and a better understanding of yourself, your team, your role as a YEP participant, as well as the Youth Expedition Project programme which you are a part of.

5. Do I have to pay to attend this training?

- LRDB trainings are made possible by Youth Corps Singapore and our YEP partners.
- The costs of delivering the training is fully subsidised by Youth Corps Singapore while the venue is provided by our YEP partners, therefore, there is no additional out-of-pocket expenses for the YEP teams and participants.

6. How to register for Our Little Red Dot and Beyond training?

- Please follow the registration instructions indicated above. Registration is on a **first-come-first-served** basis hence teams are encouraged to sign up early to avoid disappointment.
- Please note that registration and attendance taking is managed by our appointed training partners (i.e. The Thought Collective, Canact, Sequoia Group and Savoir Asia). Therefore, queries pertaining to you / your team’s registration and attendance should be directed to the relevant training partner.

7. Does the whole team have to attend the same session?

8. I have attended this training before, do I have to attend it again?

- We **strongly encourage** the **whole YEP team to sign up and attend the same session** so that this training forms part of the journey undertaken by the team together.
- Also, because our training partners update their content and delivery frequently, attending the same session allows the team to establish common grounds in knowledge and experience, which will be beneficial for personal and team development during reflections, discussions and facilitated learning.

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9. I was informed that the training session is full. What should I do?

- Registration is on a first-come-first-served basis hence teams are encouraged to sign up early to avoid disappointment.

10. How do I check if my registration / attendance was captured?

- Email the training partner you sent your registration to. Registrants should receive an acknowledgement email from the training partner if registration is successful.

11. We cannot confirm our registration / attendance now. What should we do?

- Registration must be submitted at least 3 days before the event. If you and/or your team members are unable to register by then, please register for the next available training.

12. I can't make it for all the scheduled trainings. What should I do?
